

LETTER OF GUARANTEE

Title of the Article: _____
(“ARTICLE”)

1. I, _____ (“LICENSOR”), hereby warrant that the ARTICLE is my original work and conforms to the Guidelines for the Submission of Papers of the Maritime Quarterly published by Chinese Maritime Research Institute (“CMRI”), hereinafter referred to as the PUBLISHER. Upon acceptance by the PUBLISHER, the LICENSOR thereafter grants a non-exclusive license to the PUBLISHER to use the ARTICLE in any form, including but not limited to:
 - (a) publish the ARTICLE by paper or digital format;
 - (b) digital archive, reproduce, transmit publicly by Internet, or authorize users to download, print, browse, or conduct other sales or service providing of database;

of or in any way connected with any claim that the ARTICLE infringes any intellectual property rights or other rights of any third party.
